DISCUSSION/QUESTION: The 2009 MUTCD added a tsunami evacuation route

symbol sign but did not add the hurricane evacuation route symbol sign that is used along

the east and gulf coasts. The hurricane symbol is used by the National Weather Service

to identify a hurricane. The hurricane symbol sign has been installed by states and cities

59	symbol on a white square sign as shown in Figure 2N-1. The EM-1 sign shall include a
60 61	white directional arrow (except as provided in Paragraph 3) and a white legend EVACUATION ROUTE within the blue circular symbol. The EM-1a sign shall include a
62	white EVACUATION ROUTE legend and the tsunami symbol within the blue circular
63	symbol. The EM-1b sign shall include a white EVACUATION ROUTE legend and the
64	hurricane symbol within the blue circular symbol. The EM-1, and EM-1a and EM-1b signs
65	shall be retroreflective.
